URBAN GREEN ENVIRONMENT, OUTDOOR EXPERIENCES AND SPORTS FACILITIES



- Budapest's largest public park, Népliget – currently under renovation – is within walking distance
- Sheltered, landscaped garden on 1000 sqm
- Multi-functional sports facilities: streetball court, running track, outdoor fitness for a panoramic workout on the roof
- Skygarden: walking and meditation in the building's own botanical garden
- Bicycle path right in front of the building
- Bubi (community bike) station at Népliget

HEALTH-SUPPORTING DESIGN

- Operable windows on all sides of the building
- Terrace areas available on each floor
- Multiple ways to divide office spaces into rooms for 1–50 people
- Controlled operation of elevators serving separate premises
- Outdoor work stations on the roof and in the inner garden
- Possibility to create separate guest reception/conference floors
- Use of building materials that are easy to clean and free of hazardous substances



BUILDING OPERATION FOCUSING ON HEALTH



- Disinfection points in frequently visited parts of the building
- Regular, intensive disinfectant cleaning
- Complete optimization of air supply systems
- Pre-scheduled preventive disinfection of air ducts
- Optimization of access routes and use of the elevators in the building with guest information
- Reception with HFS-trained staff
- Strict regulation of guest and courier reception and parcel handling
- In-house restaurant offering pre-ordering and delivery services

HEALTH-ORIENTED TECHNICAL SOLUTIONS

- Office occupancy signal system, parking traceability with application
- Contactless switches controllable by mobile phone (lighting/temperature)
- Sensor faucets and soap dispensers in toilets
- UV-disinfected fresh air supply, multiple air exchange
- Antibacterial filters in the ventilation system
- Contactless entrance doors to office premises
- Workstations with natural lights, provided by full glass facade
